



# Our Lady of the Way School

## 2023 School Fee Information

### School fees include the following five compulsory charges:

- *School Fee Tuition* – a compulsory fee dependent on the number of student/s from each family attending the School. This levy covers a range of items from utility charges (phone, power, rates, water, etc) school insurance, student insurance (school hours), resources, photocopying, sport, groundsman, excursion & buses.
- *Capital Levy* – a per family compulsory Levy (**that is not tax deductible**), to help meet the capital cost of the school including the servicing of loans on new buildings, refurbishments and major maintenance items. This fund is critical to the ongoing improvements at the school.
- *P&C Levy (OLW Connect)* – a per family compulsory Levy. This levy covers national registration, contribution to school resources including and not limited to library, learning support, groundsman, maintenance of playgrounds and capital projects.
- *IT Access Levy* – a compulsory levy dependent on the number of student/s from each family attending the School. This levy covers an iPad device, apps, display, projection, audio visual, subscriptions, wireless network, internet, anti-virus software, software licensing, school share point portal, Microsoft Office 365 Exchange, MS OneDrive/Office365 & Student Learning Management.
- *Consumable Levy* – a compulsory levy dependent on the number of student/s from each family attending the School. This levy supplies students with the stationery & digital resources they will need for the year in the classroom.
  - **Library Fund Tax Deductible Voluntary Contribution** – Your generosity of spirit will contribute towards the purchasing of contemporary technology for students to develop their play, passion and purposeful use of IT.
  - **Parish Voluntary Contribution** – Your generosity of spirit will contribute towards the work the Parish does in our community.
